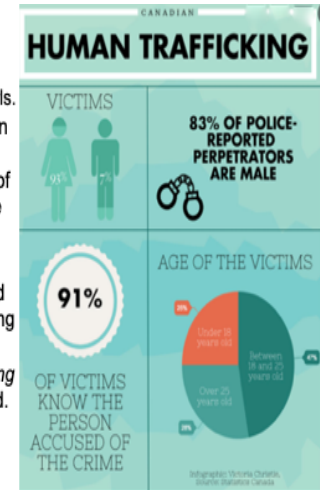


February 22 is Human Trafficking Awareness Day

Today we shine light on the connections between human trafficking, labour exploitation, and missing and murdered Indigenous women and girls. According to United Nations statistics on trafficking in persons women and girls represent 72% of identified victims of trafficking. The percentage of women and girls increases significantly in the context of trafficking for *sexual exploitation*, a market that represents 2/3 of the profits generated by exploitation.

Prayer Points:

- Pray back *Missing Persons*: Between 60 – 190 persons are reported missing in Winnipeg alone daily. There is a direct link between missing persons and exploitation.
- Pray that God will *prick the hearts of the exploiters and those suffering with a pornography addiction* to enter into a firm relationship with God.
- Pray for *current victims and the families of missing loved ones*.
- Pray for *survivors, front line workers, government officials*
